Update – New cloud-IHA Dimensions

- Release of cloud IHA Dimensions has been pushed to Q12024 Release:
 - IHA continues to work through data validations to ensure data integrity
- Benefits:
 - New encounter cubes linking inpatient and outpatient cases
 - Inpatient All Diagnosis, Outpatient All Procedures, Outpatient Diagnosis
 - Attending physician information included
 - Procedure physician information included
 - Revenue Centers and Codes will be included as data elements
 - Security enhancements include MFA for login

- With the release Q42023 dataset, the following IHA business intelligence platforms are updated:

 - All Dashboards will be updated and available by 4/11/24.

Q42023 Data Validation Notes:

- Known issues with 4Q2023 Release:
 - Service Closures:
 - IU Health Blackford ceased Inpatient and Emergency Services 10/1/2023 – no volume reported
 - Reid Health Connersville no longer reporting inpatient behavioral health (voluntary per IC 16-21-6-6)
 - Data Validation Issues:
 - Ascension St. Vincent Indianapolis had a submission issue causing material impact to underreporting for Q4. This affects inpatient and outpatient records and will be corrected with Q12024 release.
 - IHA is working with IU Health to resolve a payor mapping issue and resolution is expected by Q12024 release.
 - Plymouth Medical Center and Daviess Community Hospital reported lower than normal volumes for 11/2023-12/2023 due to cyber event & recovery. Each is working to update with Q12024 update. IHA also took update to its zip code index which has resulted in additional cases being added from 2021-2022.
 - Volume increases did not produce material affect on quality assurance checks.
